We hunt on two of the most beautiful working cattle ranches in California. The Anchor Ranch, located one mile south of town, offers level terrain with lower cover, ideal for those hunters who have some difficulty walking and especially well-suited for training young, inexperienced dogs.

Kemp Ranch, located three miles south of town in the Alabama Hills, offers more challenging terrain and is the location of our Clubhouse.


Both of these ranches welcome our hunters, recognizing the importance of good relations between ranching, the community and sportsman.


We are normally open four days a week, Thursday through Sunday. However, we will open any day of the week for groups of eight or more, who can then enjoy the exclusive use of the entire club.

All Hunts begin at the clubhouse at 8:00AM and 1:00PM. When you hunt with us, you are welcome to stay all day. If you would like us to process your birds, we ask that you stop by the clubhouse about noon with your morning harvest so we can begin processing. That way you won't miss lunch!


Our Club House is located three miles southwest of Lone Pine as the 'Pheasant flys'. Take highway 395 three miles south of town, turn west on Lubken Canyon Road, travel three miles on Lubken through Alabama Hills/Kemp Ranch, and then right on Tuttle Creek Road (1st paved road). Continue ½-mile to the "Lone Pine Pheasant Club" which is plainly marked.


